Pastoral Nominating Committee

After assessing 132 candidates over a period of 14 months, the PNC nominated the Rev. Dr. Matthew Zuehlke to be our pastor. Following a meet and greet on March 16 and after leading worship on March 17, he was elected at a congregational meeting.

He has children in elementary and middle schools and will continue his current ministry until the end of the academic year. Pastor Zuehlke will begin his work at Bluffton Presbyterian on May 19. After the election, the Pastoral Nominating Committee, comprising Craig Bowman, Ryan Brauen, Marilyn Edwards, Dick McGarrity, and Linda Nelson, was dissolved by vote of the congregation.

SESSION

Highlights of March's Session Meeting

- Furnace filters changed at the church, clocks set ahead, fixed one of the sanctuary chairs (with a wobbly back leg) and checked/replaced batteries in one of the smoke detectors. Pleased to see that the fan installed by the projector in the sanctuary (when set on high) seems to keep the unit from overheating while it is running on Sunday mornings.
- Maumee Valley Presbytery met February 20. Approved supporting actions of the following churches: First Presbyterian (Erie, MI) to sell church property and close as a congregation; First Presbyterian (Palmyra, MI) to sell church property and close as a congregation; Eastminster Presbyterian (Toledo, OH) to sell church property – note that the congregation is moving to a new location. Recipients of Matthew 25 Mission Grants shared their projects. Group of 16 from Bryan/Defiance Presbyterian Churches will travel to Mexico this summer to lead Vacation Bible School. Toledo Collingwood Presbyterian repaved their church parking lot and included half basketball court for community use (also purchased bike rack, benches, trash cans for that area). Recognized the retirement of Rev. Jeanne Gay (Toledo Collingwood).
- Ohio/Michigan) has a new program "Cultivating the Gift of Preaching." Of 650 churches in our Synod, nearly 200 are without a pastor. Program hopes to recruit elders/church leaders (within our churches) who have gift of preaching. Hope to have 35 participants each of the five years and these people would help to fill some of the open positions in our Synod. Each cycle is 18 months in length. Synod of the Covenant received a Lilly grant \$1.25 million over five-year period to cover the expenses with this program.
