April Meeting Highlights

- Approved Ministry Information Form (MIF) written by Pastor Nominating Committee.
 Approved request from Jana Mathewson to borrow tables/chairs on May 27.
- Ministry Information Form (MIF) was approved by Presbytery. MIF has been posted on Church Leadership Connection – PCUSA website. Carole Burnworth met with Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) to discuss interviewing protocols and next steps. Pastor Nominating Committee has begun receiving resumes.
- Church lawn cleaned up lots of pinecones, branches, etc. Have started spraying weeds in church landscaping. John Marshall agreed to mow church yard (including spring trim and blowing grass off sidewalks) again this year at \$40 per service same price as last year. Mower, which had been at the manse, belonged to Schillings. Approved to purchase self-propelled lawn mower (approximately \$400 from Memorial Fund) to be stored at the manse. Dave Sycks is planning to mow the manse yard while we are without a pastor.

 Gwin two weeks paid bereavement leave with an
 additional two weeks of paid leave available if
 needed.


